Software in the era of the DMP and healthcare networks

In March 2011, CLM earned “DMP-compatible” certification for its flagship *Crossway Premium* and *Médiclick* software, which let users create, fill in and view DMP electronic patient records without double entry. This certification follows on its FSE certification and incorporation of secure messaging, and heralds future developments such as access to remote health insurance services. These steps are intertwined with CLM's core focus for the past 20 years: partnering with the physicians who use its software to help their practices grow and adapt. Today, this focus means integrating new functionalities into professional software that allow users to share and exchange healthcare data.

CLM also proposes specialized medical record solutions for participation in **healthcare networks** (oncology, diabetes, perinatal care, asthma, gerontology, etc.), solutions for **shared Regional Digital Healthcare Forum (ENRS) information systems, remote health and remote medicine** platforms, a “medical office systems” offering, and so on.

Along with the Télésanté Aquitaine economic interest grouping, CLM has implemented and is managing information exchange networks for doctors (oncology, infant obesity, cardiology, diabetology, respiratory diseases and asthma, serious handicaps, pain, and bronchiolitis in children).

A TIC Santé player in Europe

CLM is also implementing innovative solutions at the European level, such as the platform developed and managed as part of the European Patients Smart Open Services (epSOS) project. This 12-country project aims to implement a pilot program in 2011 for sharing medical data in Europe. CLM is in charge of creating and hosting the web solution, and rolling it out among the test participants, three French universities participating in the Erasmus study abroad program.
