Crossway by Cegedim Logiciels Médicaux is the first software used to submit an electronic prescription

Part of the French national health insurer's PEM2D experiment

Cegedim Logiciels Médicaux (CLM), medical software publisher and service provider to healthcare professionals, announces that its Crossway software is part of a pioneering effort to implement electronic prescriptions that will simplify doctor-pharmacist interactions and make patients' course of care more secure.

CLM innovates the field of e-prescribing. Its Crossway software was allowed to create the first e-prescription to the pharmacist for transmission to the CNAM (Caisse Nationale d'Assurance Maladie), France's national health insurer. This is the first key step towards a functioning e-prescription system for medications and medical devices, christened PEM2D. The system is being tested in several departments in the Val de Loire, Saône-et-Loire and Maine-et-Loire.

The Crossway version that includes e-prescription lets doctors give their patients a printed prescription with a QR code that links to all necessary medication information. The pharmacist then scans the code, and its software displays all the prescription information. There is no need to re-enter the information, preventing mistakes and making fulfillment more secure. The encrypted code thanks to the doctor's professional cards also gives CNAM a way to fight fraud.

It also provides doctors with added-value services through information feedback on drugs delivery, with patient consent.

"Having worked on electronic treatment forms, remote health insurance services, medical messaging systems and electronic health records, we are now pleased to be a part of e-prescribing. Healthcare institutions and professionals have been communicating electronically more and more in recent years. CLM is playing an active role in that process, always by striving to meet the changing needs of medical practitioners," said *Dany Huppenoire, CEO of Cegedim Logiciels Médicaux*.
