

## **Cegedim Logiciels Médicaux (CLM) chosen to design and implement a platform for sharing medical data as part of Europe's epSOS project**

The epSOS project involves 12 countries and aims to supply cross-border services ensuring safe, efficient medical treatment to EU citizens when they travel. France, led by the efforts of the Health Ministry and ASIP Santé – the national project coordinator – is participating in this large-scale project. In 2011 CLM has been tasked with designing and implementing a pilot platform for sharing medical data among four French universities participating in the Erasmus study abroad program.

**Paris, March 9, 2011** – [Cegedim Logiciels Médicaux](#) (CLM), software publisher and service provider dedicated to the medical profession for over 20 years, announces its participation in the European Patients Smart Open Services (epSOS) project. The goal of the project for this year is to set up a pilot project for sharing medical data in Europe. CLM will create the web-based solution, provide hosting services and roll out the platform among pilot participants, four French universities (Dijon, Paris X, Poitiers and Strasbourg).

### **Providing better services to European patients**

The European epSOS project, coordinated in France by ASIP Santé, involves 12 countries: Germany, Austria, Denmark, Spain, France, Greece, Italy, the Netherlands, the Czech Republic, the UK, Slovakia and Sweden. Its goal is to create a "Patient Summary" for every European citizen, a short medical history in a standard format including essential data that can improve treatment such as allergies, previous medical and surgical history, vaccinations, any current illnesses and treatments underway, etc. Healthcare professionals in other countries would be able to consult this Patient Summary with the patient's consent.

France, the project's pilot country, wanted to combine this launch with one of the European programs most closely associated with student mobility, the Erasmus study-abroad program. The pilot phase will provide doctors at four French universities with an internet platform designed and hosted by Cegedim, a certified Health Data Hosting company.

### **In concrete terms, the epSOS service will make it possible:**

- for a French student preparing to study at a foreign university to create a Patient Summary during a visit to the university doctor. A doctor at a foreign university participating in the pilot program will be able to consult this Patient Summary.
- to give the university doctor access to the Patient Summary of a foreign student visiting a French university. This Patient Summary will have been created and saved in the student's country of origin.

### **CLM, a player in sharing health data in Europe**

The teams of the IT services division of CLM in charge of this ambitious project rely on their GRS solution for managing electronic health records, and more specifically a structured medical summary, which is being developed to meet the specific requirements of the epSOS project. The solution incorporates current norms and standards for sharing health data (IHE, HL7-CDA, CPS authentication, national healthcare ID, and health data hosting, notably). The medical summary used for the epSOS project draws on the technology found in CLM's Crossway Premium and Médiclick software.

It also represents a response to the new directions being taken in the way care is organized, linked to scarcity in the medical professions, development of group medical practices and other healthcare structures, and to the resulting needs for coordination and security. Lastly, it aims to create a comfortable experience for clients by optimizing the user-friendliness of software offerings and avoiding double entries.
