These practitioners have chosen to join a healthcare project that enhances care coordination and patient access to care.

The number of health centers, which help maintain local access to care, is rising in the region. With its full web MLM (monLogicielMedical.com)¹ solution, CLM offers these facilities an integrated tool for managing their medical and administrative activities. Whether at the health center or on the go, healthcare professionals can use MLM to securely access their work environment and functions suited to their individual practices, including patient health records, receipts and invoices. A dedicated CLM project manager is working with the health center teams to define their needs at every stage of the roll-out. To date, more than 420 health clinics and health centers have adopted a CLM solution.
